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Minutes of the 495thMeeting of the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority, UP (SEIAA) held on 29.09.2021

The meeting of 494th State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority, UP (SEIAA) was held on-line on 29.09.2021 at the Directorate of Environment. The following were present in the meeting:-

IT Park at A-6, Sector-132, Noida, M/s Triune Global Solutions Pvt. Ltd.File No. 1767/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/ 212123/2021.

SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended to extend the validity of the Environmental Clearance letter dated 12/10/2013 for 03 years i.e. 12/10/2020 to 11/10/2023 along with general conditions as earlier prescribed by authority for the construction project in its meeting dated 23.07.2021. SEIAA gone through file and documents and opined that the project proponent shall submit certified compliance report of the previous EC. Further, as mentioned in the previous EC, the project proponent should submit approved plans and proposal incorporating the conditions specified in the Environment Clearance.

Assembling of Led Lights & Components at Plot No.- 10, Sector-156, Noida, U.P., Shri Hardeep Singh, M/s Ikio Solution Pvt. Ltd. File No. 6328/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/211400/202

SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended to grant EC to the above project in its meeting dated 29.07.2021. SEIAA gone through file and documents and found that the affidavit submitted by the project proponent mentions - "Salient features of the mining project as per Form-1 submitted online by project proponent." Further, in the affidavit it is mentioned that Environmental Clearance is sought to develop a assembling of LED light and components whereas application is made under building category. Assembling of Led Lights & Components is not given in the schedule of EIA notification. SEIAA also noted that in the application it is mentioned that water required will be taken from private tankers but quantity of water required is not mentioned. Waste water from mobile toilets is proposed to be disposed by tankers but final disposal of waste water is not mentioned. Similarly construction waste has not been quantified. Proposal for

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disposal of construction waste as per rules shall be submitted along with above information.

PP is required to submit desired information and carry out necessary corrections. Consultant needs to be more professional in their approach in preparing documents. Concerned SEAC is advised to examine the projects diligently.

Common Biomedical Waste Treatment Facility at Khasra No.- 220 at Gram-Ambehta Chand, Tehsil-Rampur Maniharan, Saharanpur, U.P., M/s Greenlee Environmental Solutions. File No. 5507/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/50972/2019

SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended to grant EC to the above project in its meeting dated 30.07.2021. SEIAA gone through file and documents and found that a complaint letter dated 16.08.2021 of Shri Vishal Pundir, Rampur and letter dated 22/29.11.2020 of Shri Suresh Chandra Yadav regarding the above project has been received. SEIAA opined thata letter shall be send to MS UPPCB to get the site inspected as per CPCB guidelines.

Proposed Hospital Project at F-16, Sector-50, Noida, District- Gautam Buddha Nagar, U.P., Shri Manoj Kumar Shukla, M/s Global Health Pvt. Ltd. File No. 6261/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/205044/2021

SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC in its meeting dated03.06.2021to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC. In addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC, SEIAA added following additional specific conditions:-

- 1- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the schedule for training of various categories of employees involved in Bio-medical waste management at various levels of Bio-medical waste generation in hospital along with the name of experts etc.
- 2- The project proponent shall engage the agency authorized by UPPCB for Bio-medical waste collection, transportation, disposal and treatment.
- 3- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details on quantification of year wise CSR activities along with cost and other details. The CSR activities should be related to mitigation of environmental pollution and awareness for the same. CSR activities must not be less 2% of the project cost.
- 4- The project proponent shall install micro solar power plants in nearby villages, public place or school from CSR fund of the project for which E.C is granted in addition to toilets and water harvesting pits and carbon sequestration parks / designed ecosystems.
- 5- Project Proponent shall obtained authorization for disposal of Bio-medical waste under Bio- Medical waste management rules, 2016 from UPPCB.
- 6- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of solar power plant and solar electrification details within the project.
- 7- The project proponent shall ensure to plant broad leaf trees and their maintenance. The CPCB guidelines in this regard shall be followed.

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- 8- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months details of estimated construction waste generated during the construction period and its management plan.
- 9- The project proponent will ensure that proper dust control arrangements are made during construction and proper display board is installed at the site to inform the public regarding steps taken to control air pollution as per the Construction and Demolition Waste Management Rules.
- 10- The project proponent shall submit within next 3 months details of segregation plan of MSW/BMW.
- 11- The project proponent shall install and ensure that waste water is properly treated in STP and should be reused for gardening, flushing system irrigation purposes and washing etc. For reuse of water for irrigation sprinkler and drip irrigation system shall be installed and maintained for proper function.
- 12- Under any circumstances untreated sewage shall not be discharged to municipal sewer line.
- 13- The project proponent shall obtain forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 before the start of work.
- 14- If the proposed project is situated in notified area of ground water extraction, where creation of new wells for ground water extraction is not allowed, requirement of fresh water shall be met from alternate water sources other than ground water or legally valid source and permission from the competent authority shall be obtained to use it.
- 15- In compliance to Hon'ble Supreme Court order dated 13/01/2020 in IA no. 158128/2019 and 158129/2019 in Writ petition no. 13029/1985 (MC Mehta Vs GOI and others) anti-smog guns shall be installed to reduce dust during excavation.
- Manufacturing of API Bulk Drugs and Intermediate (New) at Plot No. B-13 & C-3, Shikohabad Industrial Estate, Firozabad., M/s Shyam Organics. File No. 6256/Proposal No. SIA/UP/IND2/206620/2021

SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended to grant EC to the above project in its meeting dated 30.07.2021. SEIAA gone through file and documents and found that details of solvent recovery has not been given in the proposal, measures for control of process emission is also not given and quantity of hazardous waste should be reviewed.

 Expansion of Existing Integrated Paints & Resins Emulsions Manufacturing Plant located at plot no. A2, B2, UPSIDC Region-V, Village-Kasna, TalukaDankaur, District-Gautam Buddha Nagar, U.P. File No. 6251/Proposal No. SIA/UP/IND2/62144/2021

SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended to grant EC to the above project in its meeting dated 30.07.2021. SEIAA gone through the file and documents and found that earlier EC was obtained in 1997. Certified compliance report has not been submitted, and the quantity and category mentioned in hazardous waste category is different in application and reply submitted on 12.08.2021. Hence SEIAA opined that the project proponent shall submit the same.

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Transfer of Sand/Morum Mining from Ganga Riverbed at Gata No.-19, Village-Ganeshpur Gang, Atarooli, Aligarh. Shri Manjeet Chawla. Area-16.0 ha. File No. 4144/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/ 73357/2018

SEIAA gone through the letter of Shri Sudheer dated 11.08.2021 regarding transfer of Environmental Clearance to the above project issued vide letter no. 75/Parya/SEAC/4144/2018 date 14.05.2018. SEIAA gone through file and documents and noted that the Environmental Clearance was issued to Shri Manjeet Chawla S/o Shri A.S. Chawla, R/o G-201 PreetVihar, Delhi. SEIAA noted that the previous lease issued to Shri Manjeet Chawla for a period of 5 years was cancelled vide DM, Aligarh order no. 1588(i)/KhanijSahayak dated 08.02.2021 and another LOI was issued to Shri Sudheer Singh Rathi S/o Shri Raghuveer Singh, M/s Rathi Builders and Suppliers A/C-187, East Evam Ansal Tronica City, LoniDehat, Ghaziabadvide letter no. 404(i)/KhanijSahayak dated 17.07.2021 for a period of 6 months. Hence SEIAA opined to transfer Environmental Clearance issued vide letter no. 75/Parya/SEAC/4144/2018 date 14.05.2018 from Shri Manjeet Chawla S/o Shri A.S. Chawla, R/o G-201 PreetVihar, Delhi to Shri Sudheer Singh Rathi S/o Shri Raghuveer Singh, M/s Rathi Builders and Suppliers A/C-187, East EvamAnsalTronica City, LoniDehat, Ghaziabad for six months and 1,20,000 m3 capacity, adding some specific conditions and with the condition that the EC will not be transferred further and after 6 months the EC will be null and void. Area mentioned in the previous EC is being transferred only. If there is a change in geo-coordinates of the area then EC will be null and void. SEIAA added following specific conditions:-

- Directions/suggestions given during public hearing and commitment made by the project proponent should be strictly complied.
- A certificate from Forest Department shall be obtained that no forest land is involved in mining or as a route and if forest land is involved the project proponent shall obtain the forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per law under the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit before the start of work.
- The mining lease holders shall, after ceasing mining operations, undertake regrassing the mining area and any other area which may have been disturbed due to their mining activities and restore the land to a condition which is fit for growth of fodder, flora fauna etc.
- 4. If the proposed project is situated in notified area of ground water extraction, where creation of new wells for ground water extraction is not allowed, requirement of fresh water shall be met from alternate water sources other than ground water or legally valid source and permission from the competent authority shall be obtained to use it.
- 5. Project Proponent should submit action plan for carrying out plantation at least @1,000 plants / ha of lease area. In this case, PP should prepare a plan, duly approved either by Forest Department or Horticulture Department, for planting at least 16,000 plants, either on government land or community land, within a periphery of 5 km from the boundary of the lease area along with provision for

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maintenance for 5 years. Survival of plants should not be less than the survival rate notified by Uttar Pradesh Forest Department otherwise it will be treated as violation of EC condition.

Rest all the content of Environmental Clearance letter no. 75/Parya/SEAC/ 4144/2018 dated 14.05.2018 shall remain same.

Sand/Morrum Mining along Betwa River Bed in Khand No.- 10/22, at Village- Beri, Tehsil- Hamirpur, District-Hamirpur., Area-36.437 Ha). File No. 4390 Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/ 216509/2021

SEIAA noted that committee in its meeting dated 06.08.2021 recommended:—
To amend the pillar coordinates in the ToR's issued vide letter Ref. No.: 370/Parya/
SEAC/4390/2017 Dated 05 September 2018 keeping rest all the conditions as the same and suggested that SEIAA may like to grant the Environment Clearance to the said project as per the 520th SEAC meeting dated 11-01-2021 along with the aforesaid amendments. SEIAA opined that the matter shall be referred to committee to examine the geo-coordinates on which the public hearing was held.

Transfer of the EC for the Janwa Silica Sand Mining project at Bhukhand no. 84-87, 100. 101, 105-110, 120, 121, 123-134, 143 village – Janwa, Tehsil- Bara, District-Allahabad, state-UP (leased area- 17.75 ha) F.N. -967

SEIAA noted that the above project was taken in its meeting dated 26.08.2021 in which SEIAA opined that project proponent shall submit transfer order issued by DM, Allahabad along with cluster certificate of the lease area, certified lease map with geocoordinates in ammonia print, approval letter of mine plan submitted along with its validity certificate. The project proponent has submitted his reply vide letter dated 10.09.2021 stating that lease transfer order was issued by office of DM, Allahabad. The project is applied for transfer of EC and as per Parivesh Portal, no cluster certificate is required for EC transfer cases. The required map were already submitted during initial applications. The mine plan was approved on 09.06.2021. SEIAA noted that physical report of the above lease is not submitted as per Parivesh Portal and the area is also not mentioned in DSR. Hence SEIAA opined that the project proponent shall submit the same.

10. <u>Transfer of Environmental Clearance for "sand mining" at Khasra no. 1 village</u> Nauraspur Tehsil- Loni, Ghaziabad U.P. (leased area- 1.81 hec).EC 188/42B/DEAC/F.N.-181-

SEIAA gone through undated letter of Mrs. Sahida Khatoon, Amroha regarding transfer of Environmental Clearance to the above project issued vide letter no. 188/GZB/DEAC/181/sand mining dated06.10.2018. SEIAA gone through file and documents and noted that the Environmental Clearance was issued to Mrs. Poonam Chauhan, M/s Omkar Lakshmi, Shubham Pvt Ltd, 1st Floor, House no.-7, Shrichandra Sarpanch wali Gali, GT road Sungarpur, North West Delhi. SEIAA noted that the previous lease issued to Mrs. Poonam Chauhan, vide letter dated 06.10.2018 for a period of 5 years was cancelled vide DM, Ghaziabad order no. 92/e-nivida/seh-e-nilami/janch/2019





dated 04.06.2019 and another LOI was issued to Smt. Sahida Khatoon, Mohammdabad Bijora, Gajrola, Amroha vide letter no. 989/Khanan/E-nivida/she-e-nilami/2020 dated 23.06.2020. Hence SEIAA opined to transfer Environmental Clearance issued vide letter no. 188/GZB/DEAC/181/sand mining dated 06.10.2018 for one year onlyfrom Mrs. Poonam Chauhan, M/s Omkar Lakshmi, Shubham Pvt Ltd, 1st Floor, House no.-7, Shri Chandra Sarpanch wali Gali, GT road Sungarpur, North West Delhi to Smt. Sahida Khatoon, Mohammdabad Bijora, Gajrola, Amroha for and 45,243 m³ capacity, adding some specific conditions, with the condition that the EC will not be transferred further. Area mentioned in the previous EC is being transferred only. If there is a change in geocoordinates of the area then EC will be null and void. SEIAA added the following specific condition:-

- Directions/suggestions given during public hearing and commitment made by the project proponent should be strictly complied.
- A certificate from Forest Department shall be obtained that no forest land is involved in mining or as a route and if forest land is involved the project proponent shall obtain the forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per law under the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit before the start of work.
- The mining lease holders shall, after ceasing mining operations, undertake regrassing the mining area and any other area which may have been disturbed due to their mining activities and restore the land to a condition which is fit for growth of fodder, flora fauna etc.
- 4. Replenishment study, duly approved by the competent authority for approving DSR for the district should be submitted within one year. In the absence of replenishment study keeping in mind various orders issued by Hon'ble NGT and development works in the State EC is accorded for a period of one year.
- 5. If the proposed project is situated in notified area of ground water extraction, where creation of new wells for ground water extraction is not allowed, requirement of fresh water shall be met from alternate water sources other than ground water or legally valid source and permission from the competent authority shall be obtained to use it.
- 6. Project Proponent should submit action plan for carrying out plantation of at least 2,000 plants, duly approved either by Forest Department or Horticulture Department, either on government land or community land, within a periphery of 5 km from the boundary of the lease area along with provision for maintenance for 5 years. Survival of plants should not be less than the survival rate notified by Uttar Pradesh Forest Department otherwise it will be treated as violation of EC condition.

Rest all the content of Environmental Clearance letter no. 188/GZB/DEAC /181/sand-mining dated 06.10.2018 shall remain same.
