The Authority after detailed discussion and deliberation decided the following:-

1. **Serial No. 01:** The Authority decided to **defer** the proposal for the submission of requisite documents viz., Copy of valid NABL accreditation of testing laboratory and proof of plantation with geo-coordinates.

Further, the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, vide its order dated 29.12.2025 in Suo Moto Writ Petition (Civil) No. 10/2025 (In Re: Definition of Aravalli Hills and Ranges and ancillary issues), has directed that

*"until further orders, no permission shall be granted for mining, whether it is for new mining leases or renewal of old mining leases,*

*in the 'Aravalli Hills and Ranges' as defined in the FSI Report dated 25.08.2010 without prior permission from this Court."*

In view of the above direction and with reference to the FSI Report dated 25.08.2010, the PP is required to submit a revised Aravalli Certificate issued by the competent authority, clearly indicating the status of the project site with respect to the Aravalli Hills and Ranges in compliance with the aforesaid order.

In addition to above, clarification is required regarding the following:

- a. The production figures for the year 2017-18, as indicated in the approved Mining Plan, do not match with those stated in the Production Certificate.
  - b. Clarification is required regarding the proposed overburden and waste generation as per the approved Mining Plan.
  - c. The Project Proponent shall submit details confirming whether a separate bank account for EIA/EMP expenditure has been opened, in compliance with Point No. 08 of the Certified Compliance Report (CCR), along with supporting proof.
  - d. The Project Proponent shall submit point-wise compliance, for the statutory EC conditions No. 1.2, 1.13, 3.1, 3.3, 3.5, 4.1, 4.7, 4.12, 14.3, 15.4, 16.11, 16.12, and 16.13.
2. **Serial No. 02:** The Authority decided to **defer** the proposal for the submission of requisite documents viz., KML file uploaded indicates that plantation has been carried out within the mining lease area, thus NOC from Revenue Department is required regarding the same; No Objection Certificate (NOC) regarding plantation proposed outside the lease area from the concerned land authority along with relevant land documents, i.e., Jamabandi; List of flora and fauna found within 10 km of the project area duly authenticated by local DCF and accordingly draft Wildlife Conservation Plan for Schedule-I species as per the Wildlife (Protection) Amendment Act, 2022, along with receipt of submission to CWLW in compliance of SEIAA order No. F(8)Gen/SEIAA/Env./2024/1361 dated 03.11.2025; NOC from WRD






