1. **Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojna at 332, 367, 368, 371, 372, 374, 375, 376, 377, 379, 380, 381, 386, 387, 733, 734, Sector-N, VasantKunj, Village- Bari-Kala, Tehsil- Sadar, District- Lucknow, U.P. File No. 4951/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/112220/2019**

SEIAA noted that the above project was taken in its meeting dated 07.12.2020 in which SEIAA opined that as the discharge in Gomti River is in the upstream of Lucknow city, project proponent shall obtain the prior permission of the competent authority for the discharge of its treated waste water and submit to SEIAA. The project proponent has submitted his reply vide letter dated 3.8.21 but the replies unsatisfactory. Hence SEIAA opined that a letter shall be sent to Chief Engineer, LDA that queries are not being solved by consultant and hence the project is being delayed.

SEIAA gone through the letter of Sri Suresh Chandra Yadav dated 13.8.21 regarding the above subject. SEIAA opined to refer the complaint to SEAC-1 and UPPCB.

SEIAA noted that SEAC-1 has recommended to grant EC to the above project. SEIAA gone through file and documents and found that in the MoM validity period of consultant has been written as 03.02.2022 while the project was heard on 07.02.2022. SEAC-1 should not have allowed the consultant to make presentation without having valid QCI (NABET) accreditation at the time of presentation.

On further examination, SEIAA opined that it is not evident from the MoM of SEAC-1 whether entire ToR has been addressed while preparing EIA/EMP report or not, this should be deliberated upon by SEAC-1 and details in tabular form should be submitted. Further, it is not evident from MoM of SEAC-1 whether issues raised during public hearing have been addressed while preparing final EIA-EMP report or not, this should be deliberated upon by SEAC-1 and details in tabular form should be submitted.

Project proponent should submit certified copy of lease map and geo-coordinate. Hence SEIAA opined to refer back the project to SEAC-1 for review/deliberations.

8. Stone (Khanda,Gitti, Boulder) Mining at Gata No.-181, Khand No.- 03, at Village- Haivatpura, Tehsil-Garautha, Jhansi, U.P. Area-1.214 ha. File No. 6582/6053/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/67633/2020

SEIAA noted that SEAC-1 has recommended to grant EC to the above project. SEIAA gone through file and documents and found that in the MoM validity period of consultant has been written as 03.02.2022 while the project was heard on 07.02.2022. SEAC-1 should not have allowed the consultant to make presentation without having valid QCI (NABET) accreditation at the time of presentation.

On further examination, SEIAA opined that it is not evident from the MoM of SEAC-1 whether entire ToR has been addressed while preparing EIA/EMP report or not, this should be deliberated upon by SEAC-1 and details in tabular form should be submitted. Further, it is not evident from MoM of SEAC-1 whether issues raised during public hearing have been

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addressed while preparing final EIA-EMP report or not, this should be deliberated upon by SEAC-1 and details in tabular form should be submitted.

SEIAA also noted that for mining lease area of 1.214 ha, ultimate depth of mining has been shown as 70mts. Project proponent/consultant should submit certificate from DGMS that the mining practice proposed by them is safe. Hence SEIAA opined to refer back the project to SEAC-1 for review/deliberations.

9. Stone (Khanda, Gitti, Boulder) Mining at Gata No.-181, Khand No.-04, Village- Haivatpura, The.-Garautha, Jhansi., M/s Saksham Contractor, Area-0.8090 ha. File No. 6583/ 6015/ Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/67701/2020

SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended to grant EC to the above project. SEIAA gone through file and documents and found that in the MoM validity period of consultant has been written as 03.02.2022 while the project was heard on 07.02.2022. SEAC-1 should not have allowed the consultant to make presentation without having valid QCI (NABET) accreditation at the time of presentation.

On further examination, SEIAA opined that it is not evident from the MoM of SEAC-1 whether entire ToR has been addressed while preparing EIA/EMP report or not, this should be deliberated upon by SEAC-1 and details in tabular form should be submitted. Further, it is not evident from MoM of SEAC-1 whether issues raised during public hearing have been addressed while preparing final EIA-EMP report or not, this should be deliberated upon by SEAC-1 and details in tabular form should be submitted.

SEIAA also noted that for mining lease area of 0.8090 ha, ultimate depth of mining has been shown as 54 mts. Project proponent/consultant should submit certificate from DGMS that the mining practice proposed by them is safe. Hence SEIAA opined to refer back the project to SEAC-1 for review/deliberations.

10. Sand/Morrum Mining from Betwa River Bed, Khand No.- 10/6, Village- Beri, Tehsil-& District- Hamirpur., M/s Kanwar Enterprises Pvt. Ltd., Area-36.437 Ha. File No. 4479/ Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/29073/2018

SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of SEAC-1 that the matter shall be discussed after submission of factual report. A reference be sent to DM, Hamirpur that no mining should take place without valid EC.

11. Granite Gitti, Khanda, Boulders & Pahari Red Morrum Mining at Khasra No./Plot No.- 2131/3, Village- Rauli Kalyanpur, Tehsil- Karwi, District- Chitrakoot., Shri Arvind Kumar Mishra, Area -2.6313 ha. File No. 5624/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/40307/2019

SEIAA noted that SEAC-1 has recommended to grant EC to the above project. SEIAA gone through file and documents and found that the above lease is not present in the DSR. Before evaluating the project SEAC-1 should have ensured that the project area has been included in DSR and without inclusion project should not have been deliberated upon.

On further examination, SEIAA opined that it is not evident from the MoM of SEAC-1 whether entire ToR has been addressed while preparing EIA/EMP report or not, this should be deliberated upon by SEAC-1 and details in tabular form should be submitted. Further, it is not evident from MoM of SEAC-1 whether issues raised during public hearing have been

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addressed while preparing final EIA-EMP report or not, this should be deliberated upon by SEAC-1 and details in tabular form should be submitted.

Hence SEIAA opined to refer back to SEAC-1 for review/deliberations.
