







**Minutes of the 107<sup>th</sup> SEAC Meeting held on 11<sup>th</sup> April 2018**

107- F. 6546/2018	Proposal for issue of Environmental Clearance for the proposed Sand Quarrying in River Vellar over an extent of 10.55.0 Ha in S.F.No.302(P) Vasistapuram Village, Kunnam Taluk, Perambalur District submitted by <b>The Executive Engineer PWD/WRD</b> , Mining & Monitoring Division - Regarding.		
	<p>The Executive Engineer, PWD, Mining &amp; Monitoring Division, Trichy has applied for Environmental Clearance on 05.04.2018 for the proposed Sand Quarry in River Vellar over an extent of 10.55.0 Ha in S.F.No.302(P) Vasistapuram Village, Kunnam Taluk, Perambalur District for the quarrying of Shoals 262361 cu.m &amp; 105500 cu.m of Sand for a period of 1 Year.</p> <p>The subject was placed before the 107<sup>th</sup> SEAC Meeting held on 11.04.2018. In the meeting, the Executive Engineer, PWD was requested to make a presentation on the proposals of the PWD. During the presentation, it was observed that the proposed site is at the curvature of the river course and at the curvature there is a village called Mettukalingarayanallur Village . Any quarrying of sand in this site will lead to erosion of the bank abetting the village thereby causing problem of flooding for the village during rainy season. Hence, the SEAC decided that this site is not suitable for undertaking quarrying activities and therefore decided to defer the proposal and directed the PWD to choose alternate site and resubmit the proposals.</p>
