The Essential features of the project are as follows:

1. Government order/ Lease details:

The mining lease was granted in G.O. 3(D) No. 113, Industries (MME2) Department dated: 10.12.2008 for a period of 20 years. The lease deed was executed on 08.01.2009. Mining operation commenced on 08.01.2009. The lease will get expire on 07.01.2029.

2. Mining Plan/Scheme of Mining approval details:

The mining plan was approved by Department of Geology & Mining, Chennai in Lr. No. 2922/MM2/2007 dated: 18.11.2008 before the grant of mining lease. The 1st Scheme of mining was not prepared and approved by the lessee in 2014-2019 due to financial crisis. To comply the rule of GCDR, 1999 the present scheme of quarrying is prepared now for the balance period of 2015-2016 to 2018-2019.

The proponent made a presentation about the salient features of the project. The members of the SEAC interacted with the proponent regarding the project proposal and environmental implications of the mining operation. The Committee decided to recommend the proposal to SEIAA for grant of Environmental Clearance subject to the normal conditions in addition to the following conditions.

- 2. Occupational Health & Safety: The proponent should take all measures to protect the safety and health of the people likely to work in the mining project.
- 3. The waste generated should be dumped in the area allocated (within Lease area) for dumping purpose ensuring its stability of slope.
- 4. The proponent shall appoint the statutory personnel in the mines as per the provisions of Mines Act, 1952 and MMR, 1961.
- 5. The proponent shall also furnish the following documents:
 - (i) A letter indicating no litigation/Court cases are pending against the proposed site from the competent authority.
 - (ii) A letter from Assistant Director Department of Geology & Mining stating that whether the quarrying operation is discontinued or suspended or closed.

this aspect clarified from a competent Authority.

(iv) The project proponent has not submitted the District Survey Report (DSR) for granite mining in Pudukottai District. On enquiry, the proponent promised to submit the same within a period of two months.
