Online proposal for granting ToR was submitted on dated 06/07/2023 and accepted by the SEIAA secretariat on dated 19/07/2023 and forwarded to SEAC secretariat. The SEAC secretariat further accepted the proposal after scrutinizing the hard copy submitted by the project proponent on dated 26/07/2023 for technical appraisal by SEAC.

The Phina Singh Multipurpose project, in Kangra district of Himachal Pradesh, has been named after Late Shri Phina Singh, a local resident of Village Niari, who initiated the idea of constructing a Dam across Chakki Khad near village Lahru at the border of Kangra and Chamba Districts for providing irrigation facilities to the fertile lands of Nurpur.

The Project envisages construction of storage concrete Dam across Chakki Khad, a small tributary of the river Beas. The dam is interlinked with Kallam Nallah, a tributary of river Beas, through a link canal of 1.21 Km length by constructing a diversion weir across Kallam Nallah. The project has been planned to cater to irrigation in culturable command area (CCA) of 4025 hectare with proposed annual irrigation (AI) to the tune 8443 hectare besides hydropower generation of 1.88 MW. The command area of the project is scattered over 60 Nos. villages of Tehsil Nurpur District Kangra (H.P.) and will extend benefit to about 25,276 habitants (based on 2001 Census)

The Dam and the weir of the project are located about 50 km from nearest rail head Pathankot Cantt and 60 Km from nearest airport Dharamshala. The location map, and command area map of the project are given with the proposal. This project was again posed for approval to the Central Water Commission (CWC), Sewa Bhawan, RK Puram, New Delhi as a Multipurpose Project by addition of 1.88 MW Hydropower component. The Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) DoWR, RD&GR, Ministry of Jal Shakti on Irrigation Flood Control & Multipurpose Projects has approved this project as a multipurpose Project in its 150th Meeting, held on 19th September 2022

ORIGINAL PROPOSAL:-

Earlier, Phina Singh Medium Irrigation project with an estimated cost of 204.51 crore (Price level 2011 & BC Ratio 1.86) for irrigation to CCA of 4025 hectare & annual irrigation of 8472.25 hectare was accepted by the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) of MoWR, RD & GR in its 109th meeting held on 14.03.2011 and approved vide letter dated 29-03-2011. The investment clearance of this project was accorded by the planning Commission Govt. of India amounting to Rs. 204.51 Crore vide letter No. 20(8)/2011-WA dated 15 July, 2011. The works in the project started in 2011 and is under construction till date. As informed so far 52% physical progress has been achieved and an expenditure of Rs. 288.11 Crore has been incurred till 31.03.2023 with the State resources.

PRESENT PROPOSAL:

With the progress in the project, it has been realized that there is a natural fall of about 65 m near the outlet of the tunnel (surge tank) and the site is conducive for power project. Further, the water requirement for irrigation purpose is not constant throughout the year and the surplus water may be utilized for power generation. Accordingly, in the present proposal, the project has been modified from *medium irrigation to multipurpose project* with proposal of power generations in addition to the irrigation component. Subsequently, on examination of power potential study, CEA approved the proposal for 1.88 MW. The cost of the power component in this project is just Rs. 19.48 Cr, which is about 3% of the project cost. There has been no change in the irrigation component in the present proposal as compared with the previous approved DPR. However, there have been some changes in design parameters of the CWC.

The SEAC in its 94th meeting held on 7-8 August, 2023, deliberated upon the three simultaneous online proposals submitted by the project proponent vide online application No. SIA/HP/RIV/438730/2023 (for EC), SIA/HP/RIV/435784/2023 (for TOR) and SIA/HP/RIV/301917/2023 (for Extension of EC).

The SEAC after detailed discussions & deliberations recommended that the SEIAA may approve the Extension of EC in accordance with office memorandum issued by the Ministry of Environment & Forests & Climate Change (IA)

vide F.NO. 1A3-22/ 28/2022-1A.111 (E 181584) dated 13-12-2022. SEIAA may also depute a team to inspect the project site to ascertain the compliance of earlier terms and conditions.

The SEAC also decided to reject the online application No. SIA/HP/RIV/438730/2023 (for EC), SIA/HP/RIV/435784/2023 (for TOR).

The case was listed in 94th meeting of the SEAC held on 7th & 8th August, 2023. After deliberating on the information submitted by the project proponent and considering the facts placed before the committee, the SEAC

recommended the case application for consideration of grant of environmental clearance by the SEIAA, subject to fulfillment of conditions annexed at Annexure-I with following special condition that:

1. **The capital cost (@ Rs. 4.00 lacs per ≤ ha.) under CER, shall be deposited in the form of Demand Draft/ Transfer in the Bank Account Number mentioned in EC letter; to the office of Director (DEST&CC), GOHP. The Director (DEST&CC) shall device a plan for this purpose within one month for that area in consultation with project proponent.**
2. The project proponent shall provide one *Pattal & Duna* making machines & one sanitary napkin manufacturing machine within 15 days from the date of issuance of EC letter to DEST&CC, Shimla for further distribution under CSR. *Pattal & Duna* Machines will be purchased from authorised/ approved sources and CMC/AMC will be assured with supplier for at least three year from date of installation. The Project proponent shall be responsible for functioning of the machines.
3. The project proponent shall prepare kml file of proposed land for undertaking plantation under EMP for monitoring purpose, and submit within one month with revenue records to SEIAA.

5. A report, along with photographs, on the measures taken shall also be included in the six monthly compliance reports being submitted by the project proponents.

The proposed project is Extraction of Sand, Stone & Bajri. Online proposal for granting TOR was submitted on dated 20/11/2021 and accepted by the SEIAA secretariat on dated 26/09/2021 and forwarded to SEAC secretariat. The hard copy was submitted by Project proponent on dated 26/11/2021.

The case was listed before the SEAC in its 83rd meeting with the following additional conditions:

1. The project proponent shall make provision to provide four plastic waste shredder, four plastic waste compactor & four baling machines to the concerned ULBs/ PRIs through Department of Environment, Science & Technology, GoHP.
2. The project proponent shall provide 6 solar lights through Department of Environment, Science & Technology, GoHP.

The project proponent was issued TOR's on dated 04.01.2022. Online proposal for granting EC was submitted on dated 05/06/2023 and accepted by the SEIAA secretariat on dated 26/06/2023 and forwarded to SEAC secretariat.

After completion of EIA report, the proponent through SPCB hold the public hearing (PH) for said project being B1 category project on dated 28/09/2022.

The case was listed in 94th meeting of the SEAC held on 7th & 8th August, 2023. After deliberating on the information submitted by the project proponent and considering the facts placed before the committee, the SEAC recommended the case application for consideration of grant of environmental clearance by the SEIAA, subject to fulfillment of conditions annexed at Annexure-I with following special condition that:

1. The capital cost (@ Rs. 4.00 lacs per ≤ ha.) under CER, shall be deposited in the form of Demand Draft/ Transfer in the Bank Account Number mentioned in EC letter; to the office of Director (DEST&CC), GOHP. The Director (DEST&CC) shall device a plan for this purpose within one month for that area in consultation with project proponent.
2. The project proponent shall provide one *Pattal& Duna* making machines& two sanitary napkin machine within 15 days from the date of issuance of EC letter to DEST&CC, Shimla for further distribution under CSR. *Pattal& Duna* Machines will be purchased from authorised/ approved sources and CMC/AMC will be assured with supplier for at least three year from date of installation. The Project proponent shall be responsible for functioning of the machines.
3. The project proponent shall prepare kml file of proposed land for undertaking plantation under EMP for monitoring purpose, and submit within one month with revenue records to SEIAA. 1000 plants of pomegranate shall be planted. Proposed plantation of Eucalyptus shall be excluded from plantation plan. Bamboo and bushes shall be included in plantation plan.
4. The project proponent shall construct 20 numbers of retaining structures/check dams along the banks of river bed with 20x5x3 meters of height.
5. The project proponent shall sensitize and create awareness among people working within the project area as well as its surrounding area on the ban of SUP in order to ensure the compliance of Notification published by MoEF&CC on 12/08/2021. A report, along with photographs, on the measures taken shall also be included in the six monthly compliance reports being submitted by the project proponents.

The proposed project is extraction of Slate/Phyllite will be done. Online proposal for granting EC was submitted on dated 28/04/2021 and accepted by the SEIAA secretariat on dated 01/06/2021 and forwarded to SEAC secretariat. The hard copy was submitted by Project proponent on dated 31.05.2021.

The case was listed before the SEAC in its 79th meeting with following observations:

1. The project proponent shall submit clarification from the Department of Industries, HP Geological Wing w.r.t the mining activity already carried out in the proposed mining area.

The case was again listed before the SEAC in its 82nd meeting with following observations:

1. A sub-committee SEAC shall visit, inspect and submit its report of the proposed mining site.
2. The project proponent did not had any clarity on proposal whether the proposal is for fresh mining or removal of already extracted/ mined & waste material lying in the project site.
3. The project proponent shall also submit the assessment of quantity of already mined material lying on site.
4. The project proponent shall submit rehabilitation plan of the project site.
5. The State Geologist may reconsider the mining plan keeping in view the sensitive ecological site conditions as the mining office letter is not technically and scientifically tenable. As per the mining officer letter no facts have been brought out w.r.t. the violation or already mining done in the area.

In order to dispose off online pending cases, the case was listed in 94th meeting of the SEAC held on 7th & 8th August, 2023 for further decision.

The Committee was apprised that the project proponent was contacted telephonically in the first week of August, 2023 to schedule & conduct site visit, he did not responded back.

The Committee decided that, the site may be visited as per convenience of project proponent and at a agreed date. Committee shall also check Latest Jamabandi/Revenue Record etc.

Item No. 4: Discussions and Decisions on important matters:

- 4.1 The Committee while appraising the proposed project of mining in its 94th meeting, viewed the drone video of mining sites of Sh. Om Prakash Khasra number 3049 falling in Mauza/Mohal Dayar Kothi Kotkandi, Tehsil Bhuntar, District Kullu, HP. The Committee while viewing the video observed that the adjoining mining is not being carried out as per the terms and conditions stipulated in the EC granted to Mr. Vikas Sohal, S/o Kashmiri Lal for mining at Khasra No : 3669/1, 3670/1, 3671/1 and 2882, of Khand Phati Diyar vide EC Letter No. SEIAA/2015/390 dated 11/03/2016 & EC extended on dated 13/6/2023 (Online proposal No. SIA/HP/MIN/298016/2023).

It is recommended that the SEIAA may issue notice to the project proponent for explanation on not following the standard conditions for scientific mining and haphazard unscientific mining and to show cause as to why the Environment Clearance should not be cancelled.

- 4.2 The Committee observed that the training of consultants approved by NABET/ QCI is necessarily required and SEIAA may take up matter with GoI, MoEF&CC.
