

- 1- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of solar power plant and solar electrification details within the project.
- 2- The project proponent shall ensure to plant broad leave trees and their maintenance. The CPCB guidelines in this regard shall be followed.
- 3- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details on quantification of year wise CER activities along with cost and other details. CER activities must not be less 2% of the project cost. The CER activities should be related to mitigation of Environmental Pollution and awareness for the same.
- 4- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of estimated construction waste generated during the construction period and its management plan.

SEIAA gone through file and documents and found that in the water balance chart water requirement for domestic/drinking is mentioned as 435 m³/ day while for flushing and green belt it is mentioned as 221 m³/day & 84 m³/day respectively and a STP 600 m³/day has been proposed. On the same page in the description of the water usage, it is mentioned that 130 KLD is likely to be generated from the proposed project will be treated through sewage treatment plant (125 KLD) and the treated water will be used for Horticulture (4.0 KLD), DG Set cooling (7 KLD) and Toilet flushing (33 KLD). SEIAA opined that project proponent shall clarify the above and submit the revised water balance along

with the water balance for the monsoon season also. Further excess/unused treated waste water has been shown to be utilized for ferti-irrigation but no feasibility report has been submitted in this regard. SEIAA opined that the project proponent shall submit feasibility report for the use of treated waste-water for ferti-irrigation as per CPCB guidelines along with the land available for this purpose and MOU signed with the farmers, if the land does not belong to the project proponent.

 8. The project proponent shall install micro solar power plants, toilets in nearby villages, public place or school from CER fund of the project for which E.C is granted in addition to and water harvesting pits and carbon sequestration parks / designed ecosystems.
 9. The project proponent shall obtain the forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per law under the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 before the start of work.
 10. In compliance to Hon'ble Supreme Court order dated 13/01/2020 in IA no. 158128/2019 and 158129/2019 in Writ petition no. 13029/1985 (MC Mehta Vs GOI and others) anti-smog guns shall be installed to reduce dust during excavation.
 11. If the proposed project falls in Critically Polluted Areas (CPAs), Severely Polluted Areas (SPAs) the provision of the mechanism framed regarding compliance of Hon'ble NGT order in OA 1038/2018 dated 19-08-2019 by MoEF& CC, Govt. Of India vide letter dated 31-10-2019 shall be followed in letter and spirit.
 12. All the additional conditions for grant of Consent to Establish (CTE)/Consent to Operate (CTO) related to Pollution mitigation measures as prescribed in the office memorandum of MoEF&CC, Gol. dated 31.10.2019 and as deemed fit by UP Pollution Control Board in the consent orders shall be followed by Project Proponent.
 13. If the proposed project is situated in notified area of ground water extraction, where creation of new wells for ground water extraction is not allowed, requirement of fresh water shall be met from alternate water sources other than ground water or legally valid source and permission from the competent authority shall be obtained to use it.
- 13. Discussion on letter dated 28/07/2020 regarding omission of conditions for certified compliance report in Commercial Project at plot no.- C3-E1, Sector-129, Noida, M/s Gulshan Homes and Infrastructure Pvt. Ltd. File No. 3857/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/154786/2020**
- SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended to omit the condition "certified compliance report for the earlier environmental clearance" mentioned in minutes of 474th SEAC meeting dated 26/06/2020 as requested by project proponent due to covid-19 pandemic. SEIAA also noted that it is not final recommendation of SEAC for ToR/EC. SEIAA opined that certified compliance report for the earlier EC condition shall not be omitted and condition shall be imposed for its submission at a later specified date.





14. Discussion on letter dated 29/07/2020 of Common Bio Medical Waste Facility Operators Association, Kanpur.

SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended that the letter dated 29/07/2020 of Shri Suresh Chand Yadav, Legal Officer, Common Bio Medical Waste Facility Operators Association should be sent to CMO, Sonbhadra and Regional Officer, UPPCB, Sonbhadra for providing the factual report of the project and a copy of the same may be sent to complainant for information. SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC.

15. Discussion on letter dated 18/08/2020 of M/s VRY Industrial Park LLP regarding storage of hazardous chemicals under manufacture, Storage and Import of Hazardous Chemicals Rules (MSIHC Rules), 1989 and amended till date for expansion of Logistic Park (warehouse) project at Gata No. 188 and 198, Village-Sikandrabad Dehat, District-Bulandshahar, U.P.

SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC that the project proponent doesn't require any separate Environment Clearance under schedule 6(b), but the project proponent shall obtain the amendment in the Environment Clearance letter dated 06/06/2019 with the additional storage of Hazardous chemicals under MSIHC Rules, 1989 and its amendments and shall submit the Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) and steps to be taken/ facilities to be maintained by project proponent for storage of hazardous chemicals. The project proponent shall also obtain other necessary approvals from competent authorities for the storage of hazardous chemicals.



SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended to grant the environmental clearance in view of MoEF&CC Notification dated 08/03/2018 along with general and specific conditions stipulated by the SEAC in its 467th SEAC meeting dated 04/06/2020. SEIAA gone through the file and documents along with the summary of litigation pending which has been submitted by project proponent, which also mentions that "The management committee (which was terminated by Legislative Order)- while Govt Appointed Administrator was managing the affairs of the Society had taken an illegal & VOID-AB-INITO loan 6 Crores from Syndicated Bank. The loan was taken in full violation of UP Cooperative Act, Without Approval of General Body, Without Taking Mortgagor permission etc. etc. etc. The loan became 2010. Loan was guaranteed by contractor, President & Secretary of the Society." SEIAA opined that the project proponent shall submit the latest status also Clarifying who is the authorized owner/signatory of "Vrinda City" at Plot No. GH-2, Sector- PHI-04, Greater Noida, District-Gautam Buddha Nagar.
