
It was decided that as per the Assistant Director, Geology and Mining, Villuppuram has informed in his letter dated: 28.05.2018 that “transport permit has been issued to the lessee on 03.07.2014 vide bulk permit No. 21283 on payment of Royalty of Rs. 76000/- to transport 20.558 cu.m of Black granite from the above said quarry. Further, no transport permit was issued to the lessee subsequence to 03.07.2014 to till date”.

This will be dealt in accordance with the Environment Impact Assessment Notification, 2006 as amended.

Whereas Thiru.Badrinarayanan has filed a W.P No. 7964 of 2019 in the Hon’ble High


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Court of madras in the affidavit in para 7 he has mentioned that “ the quarry were stopped on and from 12.01.2017, by the District Collector of villupuram District, on the instruction of the 1st respondent (Industries Department) for no fault of the petitioner”.

In this case, it has been mentioned that “the quarry were stopped on and from 12.01.2017, by the District Collector of villupuram District. The MoEF&CC vide Z-11013/24/2017-IA-II(M) dated 03.04.2017 addressed to the principal secretary, industries department, Chennai stated that “ the mine leases which continues to operate without obtaining EC after 15.01.2016 shall be considered as violation cases and the same shall be dealt in accordance with the violation policy under Environment Impact Assessment Notification, 2006 as amended.”

Hence, the proposal shall be considered as a case of violation and shall be dealt by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF & CC) Notification dated 14.03.2017 and subsequent MoEF & CC, O.M dated 15.03.2018.

Hence, clarification is requested in the above proposal to proceed further. The above facts shall be informed in the counter affidavit on behalf of SEIAA for the above said W.P No. 7964 of 2019 in the Hon'ble High Court of madras.

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
