Mining of minerals (<math>\leq 250</math> ha of mining lease area in respect of non-coal mine lease).</p> <p>The representative of the proponent and their consultant SV Enviro Labs &amp; Consultants have attended the meeting.</p> <p>The Committee noted that as per cluster letter issued by Asst. Director of Mines &amp; Geology, palamaneru, vide Lr. dated: 10.08.2022, there are no quarry leases granted within the radius of 500 mts area. This is a standalone mining unit.</p> <p>The Committee noted that the extent of proposed mine lease area is <b>1.990 Ha.</b> The project falls under B2 category. The Committee noted that the extent of proposed mine lease area is **4.5 Ha**. The project falls under **B2 at par with B1** category

The project proponent has obtained TOR on 21.06.21 and public hearing was held on 24.06.2022.

Employment problems , providing of school infrastructure , construction of temple , utilisation of CSR funds for village etc were the major issues raised in the public hearing .

**Reply of the proponent during the public hearing is as follows:**

**On behalf of the proponent , the consultant informed that they will form a coordination committee with all the mining managements , carry out skill development training and see that the 3 families adjacent to the mine will not have any problem and will consider all the remaining suggestions given by the participants and requested the villagers to support them.**

**The committee appraised the final EIA and noted that the predominant wind direction is from North –east to south – west and maximum GLCs observed is within the standards and falls at a distance of 1.13 KMs in south and south – west direction of the mine. There is house and temple at a distance of 160mts in north side and to maintain 200mts distance for habitation as per NGT norms , modified mining plan is required.**

In 195<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting recommended to raise ADS for submission of Modified mining plan as there is one house and Temple within 200m to comply with NGT Norms and accordingly proponent submitted modified mining plan dt.12.09.2022 by leaving 0.828 Ha as non-mining zone.

The proponent volunteered to provide Digital Class Rooms and primary benches to Varamanur village primary school as a part of Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) activity and shall maintain till the life of the mine.

The Committee after examining the project proposals, presentations, EIA appraisal, Modified mining plan, MoEF&CC' Notifications & OMs and detailed deliberations, recommended to issue **Environmental Clearance**
