M/s. NCL Industries Limited Proposed to establish captive coal based Power plant with a capacity of 30MW at Mattapalli village, Mattampalli Māṇḍal, Nalgonda District for which we obtained Environmental Clearance from SEIAA vide order no. SEIAA/AP/NLG-35/2011/692 dated 27.04.2013 which is having validity upto 31.03.2021 based on Gazette Notifications 1141 (E) dated 29th April, 2015, 4254 (E) dated 27th November, 2020 and SO 221 (E) dated 18th January, 2021.

The unit obtained EC in 2013 under category B when it was United Andhra Pradesh. Due to state bi-furcation in June, 2014, now the general condition is applying for project due to inter-state boundary of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh at a distance of 2.1 KM from the site and hence the project is now coming under category A

Note on file transfer of NCL Captive Power Plant from SEIAA, Telangana to MoEF&CC

M/s. NCL Industries Limited Proposed to establish captive coal based captive Power plant with a capacity of 30MW at Mattapalli village, Mattampalli Mandal, Nalgonda District for which they obtained Environmental Clearance from SEIAA vide order No. SEIAA/AP/NLG-35/2011/692 dated 27.04.2013.

Applied for extension of validity period of Environmental Clearance to the MoEF&CC vide proposal no IA/TG/IND/205416/2021 dated 23.03.2021.

EDS raised by MoEF&CC on 31.03.2021 i.e., “your proposal is returned due to the following: on perusal of the records, the EC was accorded by SEIAA. In view of this, application may be submitted to SEIAA and request them to transfer to MoEF&CC along with entire records due to the applicability of general condition as stated in the cover letter”

Based on the EDS, again applied to the Telangana SEIAA for the transfer of records from SEIAA Telangana to MoEF&CC vide proposal no: SIA/TG/THE/207358/2021 dated: 31.03.2021.

The SEAC considered the request of proponent and after detailed discussion, the SEAC recommended transfer the proposal for extension of EC. Subsequently, the proposal was examined by the state Environmental Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Telangana in its meeting held on 01.05.2021. The SEIAA decided to transfer the proposal for extension of EC along with records of previous EC to the MoEF&CC and sent the Letter to the MoEF&CC vide Lr.no: SEIAA/TS/OL/SRPT-30/2021-468 dated: 05.05.2021. Copy of the letter of file transfer acknowledgment enclosed as **Annexure-I**

Kind attention is invited to the subject and references cited above. The proponent has submitted an application vide reference 2nd cited above to the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Telangana seeking EC Extension validity period issued to 30 MW Coal based Captive Power Plant within their existing Cement Plant premises.

The above proposal was examined by the State Level Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC) in its meeting held on 24.04.2021 and based on the information furnished, the SEAC observed as following:

The proponent earlier obtained EC from SEIAA vide order 27.04.2013 for establishment of 30 MW Coal based Captive Power Plant.

It was informed that due to financial reason they could not implement the project and now the unit proposed to initiate project activities and expected to complete the project within next 3 years period.

It was also informed that as per S.O.1141 (E) dt.29.04.2015 the EC is valid for a period upto 26.04.2020. Further, due to Covid conditions in the Country the validity of EC is now upto 31.03.2021, as per S.O.4254 (E), dt.27.11.2020 issued by MoEF&CC, GoI. It was also informed that the Ministry vide S.O. 221 (E) dt.18.01.2021 stated that the time period between 01.01.2020 and 31.03.2021 shall not be considered while calculating validity period of EC.

Due to State bifurcation in 2014, the project now becomes Category-A project due to applicability of general condition i.e., interstate boundary exists at a distance of 2.1 km from the project site. It was informed that accordingly, the proponent applied for extension of EC at the MoEF&CC. But, the MoEF&CC, GoI raised EDS returning the proposal and stating that the application may be submitted to SEIAA and requested them to transfer to MoEF&CC, GoI along with entire records due to applicability of general condition, as stated in the covering letter.

Hence, it was requested to forward their application along with records of previous EC to the MoEF&CC, GoI for validity extension of existing EC for another 3 years.

The SEAC considered the request of proponent and after detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended to transfer the proposal for extension of EC.

Subsequently, the proposal was examined by the State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) in its meeting held on 01.05.2021 and keeping in view of the above recommendations, the SEIAA decided to transfer the proposal for extension of EC along with records of previous EC to the MoEF&CC, GoI.

In view of above, the above mentioned project proposal along with records of previous EC is hereby transferred to the MoEF&CC, GoI, for further necessary action.
