ORDER:

In the reference 1st and 2nd read above, the Government have proposed to grant of ML for Iron Ore over an extent of 10.00 acres in S.No.370 & 58/p of Obulapuram (V), D.Hirehal (M), Anantapur District for a period of 20 years in favour of M/s.Sai Balaji Minerals Managing Partner Sri. M. Sanjeevarayudu subject to submission of AMP under rule 22(4) of M.C.Rules,1960, and also requested to GOI vide Lr.No.10474/M.III(1)/06-1, dt:08-08-06 for prior approval under Section 5(1) of MM(D&R)Act,1957 to grant of the ML on the above subject area.

2. The Director of Mines and Geology in the reference 3rd read above, has sent proposals along with Approved Mining Plan for grant of ML for Iron Ore over an extent of 10.00 acres in S.No.370 & 58/p of Obulapuram (V), D.Hirehal (M), Anantapur District for a period of 20 years in favour of M/s.Sai Balaji Minerals, Managing Partner Sri. M. Sanjeevarayudu subject to obtaining the prior approval of GOI under section 5(1) of MM(D&R) Act,1957 and also consent for Establishment from APPCB as per S.O.60(E), Dt:27-01-94.

3. The Government of India in the reference 4th read above, have conveyed the approval of the Central Government under section 5(1) of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 to the grant of mining lease for Iron ore over an area of 10.00 acres in Obulapuram (V), Anantapur (Dt) in favour of M/s.Sai Blaji Minerals for a period of 20 years,

4. After careful examination of the matter, Government, hereby grant of Mining Lease for Iron Ore over an extent of 10.00 acres in S.No.370 & 58/p of Obulapuram (V), D.Hirehal (M), Anantapur District for a period of 20 years in favour of M/s.Sai Balaji Minerals, Managing Partner Sri. M. Sanjeevarayudu subject to submission of pattadar consent before entering in to the land as per rule 22(3)(h) and also consent for Establishment from A.P.Pollution Control Board as per S.O.60(E), Dt:27-01-94 before execution of lease deed also subject to satisfying the conditions in Form – K prescribed under the Mineral Concession Rules, 1960 and to the additional conditions specified in the Appendix to this order.

5. The rates of Royalty, Dead Rent, Surface Rent and water charges shall be collectable as follows or as revised by the Government from time to time:

IRON ORE

:: Twenty Seven Rupees per tonne or as revised from time to time.

(i) Lumps:

- a) with 65 percent Fe content or more

The grantee should pay a deposit Rs.10,000/- as prescribed under rule 32 of the Mineral Concession Rules, 1960 before the Lease is actually executed.

The grantee should execute the lease deed within the time limit specified in Rule 31 of Mineral Concession Rules, 1960.

The terms and conditions referred to in para -4 of this order are subject to such further modifications, additions and alterations as may be ordered before the lease deed is executed.

The Director of Mines and Geology is requested to take necessary further action for the execution of the lease deed after satisfying himself that the grantee fulfils all the required provisions of the amended Act and Rules. As soon as the deed is executed, the date of such execution should be reported to the Government.

Note: The grant is liable for cancellation should it be found it was grossly inequitable or was made under a mistake of fact or owing to misrepresentation or fraud or in excess of authority.
