

**Construction of New Integrated Terminal Building with Allied Works at
Imphal International Airport, Imphal (Manipur State)
by Airports Authority of India**

Brief Summary

- The proposed project is Construction of New Integrated Terminal Building with Allied Works at Imphal International Airport, Imphal (Manipur State)
- Reference point of the Site is 24° 45' 45.75" N and 93° 54' 19.66" E
- Construction of a centrally air-conditioned Modular New Integrated Terminal Building with all modern facilities and amenities. The Terminal Building with area of 28125.00 sq.m shall be designed for 200 international and 1000 Domestic passengers at a time with swing operations.
- Construction of Apron suitable for eight (08) nos. parking bays for A321 as per lay out plan (Annex D) of approximate area 187 m X 142 m (22560 sq.m) with 7.5 m shoulder on three sides suitable for operation of A321.
- Construction of two link taxiways of 144 m X 23 m with shoulder connecting the Apron with the Runway
- Construction of New Technical Block cum Control Tower of approx. 40 m height and 4000 sq.m area.
- Other Allied Works including Electrical Work, CNS Works, IT & Airports Systems Works, etc.
- The site for new integrated terminal building and allied works is free from vegetation and buildings.
- The proposed development including New integrated terminal building, apron, taxiway, etc, at existing Imphal Airport will be located within available 1102 Acres land. Therefore, no land acquisition is involved.
- Fresh water requirement for the proposed civil enclave will be 389 kl/day for domestic purpose. From the new integrated terminal building 472 kld sewage will be generated.
- For HVAC and Green Belt/landscaping treated water from STP will be utilized.
- No water body will be affected by the New Integrated Terminal Building works and allied works within Imphal Airport.
- No forest land is involved in the site for New Integrated Terminal Building and allied works within Imphal Airport.
- There is no critically protected area, state and national boundary within 10 km distance from the site.
- There is no ecological sensitive area, biosphere, critically polluted area, state or state/international boundary within 10 km distance from site within the Imphal Airport.
- Solid waste generated at the New Integrated Terminal Building will be 1575 kg/day.
- The estimated cost of new Integrated Terminal Building and Allied works will be is Rs 727 Crores.
