Sub: Permission under Reg.111(3) of the Metalliferous Mines Regulations, 1961, to carry out mining operations within 7.5m of the common boundary between Kaliapani Chromite Mine of M/s Balasore Alloys Ltd.(BAL) & Jindal Chromite Mine of M/s Jindal Stainless Limited (JSL).

Sir,

Please refer to your joint application vide letter No.BAL/Mines/2236 dated 20.04.2015 and the enclosed plan bearing No. BAL/JSL/01/15 dated 13.03.2015 on the above subject.

The matter has been examined in the light of what has been stated in the application.

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Chief Inspector of Mines (also designated as Director-General of Mines Safety) under the provisions of Regulations 111(3) of the Metalliferous Mines Regulations, 1961 and by virtue of authorisation granted to me by the Chief Inspector of Mines (also designated as Director General of Mines Safety) under Section 6(1) of the Mines Act, 1952, I, hereby permit you to work the above two adjoining mines within 7.5m of common boundary in chromite band-1 between +146mRL to +106mRL as shown on the enclosed plan No.BAL/JSL/01/15 dated 13.03.2015, subject to the following conditions being complied with:

- 1.0 The boundary of mines shall be demarcated on the surface by suitable pillars. If any boundary pillar(s) is disturbed while working near the mine boundary, the same shall be re-established on the floor of the quarry so that common boundary between two mines can be demarcated.
- 2.0 The workings of the mine shall be shown on all statutory plans of both mines. Conditions of the relaxation granted under Regulation 106(2)(b) of the Metalliferous Mines Regulations, 1961, shall be strictly complied with by the respective mines while working near the common boundary.
- 3.0 "Sequence of mining operation" and "modalities for working" near the common boundary, framed jointly by the Managers of both the mines and submitted along with the application, shall be complied with.
- 4.0 Code of practice for blasting near the common boundary shall be framed by managers of the both mines in consultation with each other ensuring withdrawal of persons from danger zone during blasting and developing a full proof system of warning persons in the danger zone on both mines before blasting and the same shall be implemented.

4.0 Provisions of Regulation 111(2) of the Metalliferous Mines Regulations, 1961, shall be strictly complied with from +106mRL and below.

5.0 Chrome Ore band-1 in both the mines shall not be worked by underground method without obtaining prior permission in writing from this Directorate.

6.0 In the event of any change in the circumstances connected with this permission which is likely to endanger the life of persons employed in the mine or the mine, the mining operations for which this permission has been granted shall be stopped forthwith and intimation thereof shall be sent to this Directorate. The said mining operation shall not be resumed without express and fresh permission in writing from this Directorate.

7.0 If at any time any one of the conditions, subject to which this permission has been granted, is violated or not complied with, this permission shall be deemed to have been revoked with immediate effect.

8.0 This Permission may be amended or withdrawn at any time if considered necessary in the interest of safety.

9.0 This Permission is being granted under Regulation 111(3) of the Metalliferous Mines Regulations, 1961 only without prejudice to any other provisions of law which may be or may become applicable at any time.

11.0 This Directorate shall be informed as soon as the mining operations are commenced in accordance with the above permission. Intimation about completion of the mining operations should also be sent promptly and in any case not later than one month thereof.
