

Compliance to Additional Information/Inputs asked during the EAC Meeting

- 1. Production during FY 2015-16 is 42.46 KLPD i.e. higher than the sanctioned capacity of 35 KLPD, which amounts to non-compliance of the existing EC conditions.**

Compliance:

During the Financial Year 2015-16, the fermentable sugar content in the Molasses was high, and as such the yield of the Rectified Spirit per tonne of the Molasses was 280 liters/tonne of molasses, compared to the Normal Yield of the Rectified Spirit, i.e. 260 to 265 Liters/tonne of Molasses. The alcohol content in the fermented wash was observed to be around 8 percent, which was greater than normal values of the alcohol content in the fermented wash i.e around 7 percent. The influence of the above two factors has resulted in the slightly higher Rectified Spirit production. However, the effluent quantity i.e. Spentwash generated from the fermentation process was around 8 to 8.5 liters/liter of Rectified Spirit Production. Which is less, as the Normal value of spent wash generated is about 10 liters/liter of Rectified Spirit Production. Thus, the Organic Loading on the ETP unit remained unaltered and there was no shock loading on the performance of the ETP.

In the view of above facts, we request you to waive the Penal Action against the industry, having produced marginally higher production than the Environmental Clearance Conditions.

We have never exceeded the production quantities subsequently. In future also, we promise that we shall abide strictly to the Environmental Clearance Conditions.

- 2. The earlier EC dated 14th May 2003 was issued in favor of M/s Brihan Maharashtra Sugar Syndicate Ltd and should have been transferred in the name of M/s Brima Sagar Maharashtra Distilleries Ltd.**

Compliance:

The Brima Sagar Maharashtra Distilleries Limited, has applied for transfer/Change of the name, and accordingly, the TORs were issued in the name of M/s. Brima Sagar Maharashtra Distilleries Limited. However, as directed by the Expert Appraisal Committee, we had once again applied online for the change in the name of the Industry for Environmental Clearance with necessary documents, immediately after the Expert Appraisal Committee Meeting, on 27th July 2018. The necessary documents are once enclosed as Annexure I.

- 3. Proposed fresh water requirement of 610 cum/day would be reduced to 455 cum/day. The water balance needs to be revised accordingly.**

Compliance:

As per the revised water balance, the net water requirement for the proposed Distillery shall be **417 cum/day**. The process effluent (Spentwash) quantity shall be **310 cum/day** and the quantity of the domestic effluent shall be **17 cum/day**.

4. STP to be installed for the treatment of domestic effluent.

STP of capacity **25m³/day** shall be installed as per the directives of the EC.

5. Plan for Corporate Environment Responsibility (CER) and the traffic management to be submitted.

A. Corporate Environment Responsibility:

As per the Office Memorandum **F.No. 22-65/2017-IA-III** Dated 1st May 2018, **1%** of the total project cost is to be spent on the CER/CSR activities. Accordingly, **Rs. 48 Lacs** is earmarked for the activities to be carried out under CER/CSR activities, as the cost of the proposed project is **48 Crores** (Expansion of Distillery capacity from 35 KLPD to 65 KLPD). The detailed budget allocated for various activities is listed in the following table.

B. Traffic Management Details after the proposed expansion of the Distillery capacity from 35 KLPD to 65 KLPD

The industry has 15 meters wide internal roads for loading and unloading of raw materials and finished products, and a parking area of 8000 sq. meters. Daily around 25 to 30 tankers of

Molasses are likely to be unloaded at the factory site. However, at any point of time not more than 2-3 tankers shall be unloading at the factory site. For transporting the finished product Liquor, Daily not more than 3 trucks shall be loaded for Dispatches, and 2-3 Tankers shall be used for transporting ODS/SDS. Besides there are only 3 Cars and about 50 Two-wheelers which are to be parked in the reserved parking area.

There will not be any congestion of the traffic either inside the factory premise or in the neighborhood area outside of the factory.

7. Redressal of the issues raised during the public hearing.

For the Public Hearing, there are around 100 participants who were present, out of which 24 participants including the chairman and MPCB Regional and Sub-Regional Officers asked questions regarding the details of the expansion of the Distillery Capacity from 35 KLPD to 65 KLPD. All the participants supported the proposed expansion of the Distillery Capacity from 35 KLPD to 65 KLPD except one Mr. Nitin Waghmare, who raised the issue that spent wash is disposed on the land through tankers and made the land infertile. However, many other participants did not support the observations of Mr. Nitin Waghmare.

Another Participant Mr.Kalyan Landage, requested the management to supply RO drinking water, for which the Management have agreed.



BRIHANS and BSMDL are individually referred to as "Party" and collectively as "Parties".

WHEREAS BRIHANS has been granted various licenses more particularly described in Schedule I attached to this Agreement under the provisions of the Bombay Prohibition Act, 1949 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Permits.')

AND WHEREAS BSMDL is desirous of purchasing the ongoing manufacturing business including manufacturing licenses ("Business"). Therefore BSMDL is desirous of getting the Permits transferred to its name to run the Business after the acquisition of the Business by BSMDL.

AND WHEREAS BRIHANS intends to transfer the said Permits to BSMDL subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement;

NOW THEREFORE THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS UNDER:

1. This Agreement is subject to the necessary sanction from the appropriate government authorities.
2. The Transfer price of the Permits is agreed and accepted to be **16,80,00,000.00 (Rupees Sixteen Crores Eighty Lacs Only)** ("Transfer Price").
3. BSMDL understands that BRIHANS has initiated the procedure with the concerned authority to transfer the Permits in the name of BSMDL. It is agreed by the Parties that if such transfer of the Permits are not granted by the concerned authority in favour of BSMDL despite the best effort of BRIHANS, BRIHANS shall run the Business after the acquisition of the Business by BSMDL with the Permits till the date the Permits are transferred in the name of BSMDL. In such event the risk and cost of running the Business and the profit / loss out of the Business shall be solely on BSMDL. Once the Permits are transferred in the name of BSMDL, BSMDL shall run and operate the Business.

BSMDL agrees to pay the entire transfer price of the Permits within one month upon the completion of the transfer of the Permits.

If BSMDL is not able to complete the commitment of the payment of the Transfer Price under this Agreement, BRIHANS reserves the right to give an extension of 10 days in writing for payment and if payment is not received after the extended period also, BRIHANS reserves the right to cancel this Agreement. In such case, the Permits would be transferred back legally to BRIHANS at the expense of BSMDL after the expiry of the said period of 10 days.

6. Any claim, dispute, difference or question arising out of, or in respect of or in relation to the Agreement shall be settled amicably between the Parties within a period of 30 (Thirty) days from the Party raising a claim, dispute, difference or question, failing which the same shall be referred to arbitration of a sole arbitrator under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, and the place of arbitration shall be at Pune. The language of arbitration shall be in English.
7. This Agreement shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts in the city of Pune.
8. Any notice to be given by the Parties hereto to each other under this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be transmitted (a) by registered mail, postage prepaid or by courier service or by personal delivery as elected by the Party giving such notice, at the addresses as mentioned below

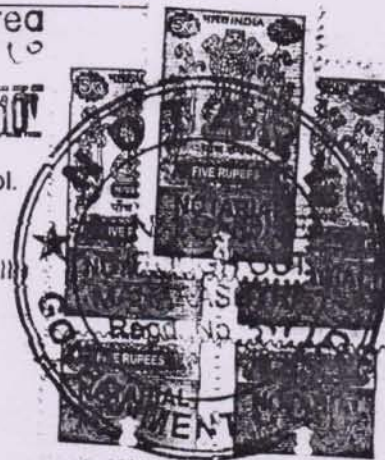


